

# List of impacted services

A scheduled data center migration will take place on 25th February 2023 starting at 22:00 CET, with impacts on the following services.

The primary site will be moved from Senigallia to Milan, and Senigallia will become the disaster recovery site.

In order to complete migration we will expose the services on a new proprietary subnet.

The changement of IP addresses may impact your services if you have whitelisted IPs or similar activities. It will be necessary to **add** the pointing to the IPs currently in use with new pre-established IPs without removing the existing.

In this case you should in alternative:

- **Add the entire Namirial subnet** 185.217.28.0/22 (in this way every change in the future will be completely transparent for you);
- **Add the specific \$new\$ in the list *without removing the existing one***;
